

Treasures of Budapest

Visit to the Royal Academy of Arts, Piccadilly
Thursday 2nd December 2010



This exhibition features over 200 works of paintings, drawings and sculpture from the early Renaissance to the twentieth century. It will showcase the breadth and wealth of one of the finest collections in Central Europe, housed in the Museum of Fine Arts, Budapest with additional key loans from the Hungarian National Gallery. Selected works by artists including Leonardo da Vinci, Raphael, El Greco, Rubens, Goya, Manet, Monet, Schiele, Gauguin and Picasso will be on display, many of which have not previously been shown in the U.K.

The cost of the visit is £34 and includes audio guides; for Members of the Royal Academy the cost will be £24. The coach will leave Leiston (Nunn's car park) at 7.00 a.m, Aldeburgh Tourist Office at 7.10 a.m, and Wickham Market at 7.30 a.m. Our visit to the Royal Academy starts at 11.00 a.m and there should be time for lunch and some Christmas shopping.
